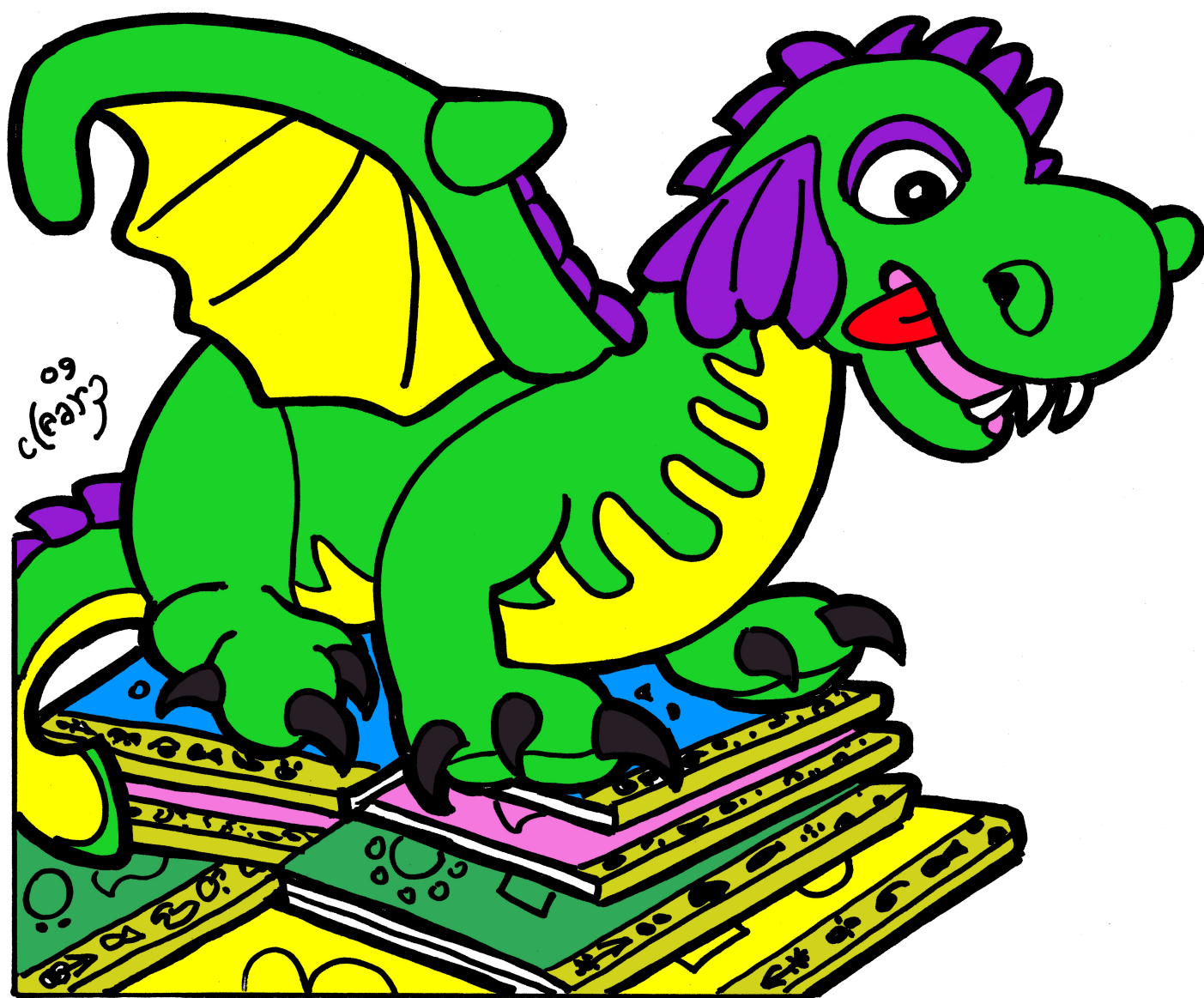

Permission is granted to reprint all articles, lists, and flyers so long as the author and the *Bulletin* are credited. All art is copyrighted by the artist, unless otherwise specified. An exception is granted in the case of art that appears in a convention flyer.

The editor encourages submission of lengthy written material and art, covers and illos. Contributions and LoCs via electronic means are highly desirable. If you wish to use the Internet, you send the article as electronic mail or an attachment. If you wish to send the editor computer media, IBM compatible file formats are acceptable. CLEARY COMMENTS

Welcome to the March 2025 issue of the *SFC Bulletin*. Hopefully, there will be another issue before the next **DeepSouthCon** (63) in New Orleans, LA in October. Please send submissions!

At the next **DeepSouthCon**, *SFC* will propose the following amendment to the DSC by-laws.

Motion- *"If there is an issue that cannot be resolved by the seated DSC under current bylaws, the SFC executive committee is empowered to resolve it (assuming that it accepts)."*

The purpose of this motion is a last chance fail safe in case of emergency where the seated *DSC* convention organizers abdicate their responsibilities for any reason. The *SFC* officers then can step in to help out or deal with the situation in the best interests of keeping the *DSC* convention on-going. It does NOT require *SFC* to step in or be legally or financially responsible for any obligations or debts incurred by the seated *DSC* convention. The wording may need to be modified as needed during the next *DSC* business meeting.

For example, imagine if the *DSC* is bid for and won two years out (as usual) by an existing convention. However, a year later, that existing convention closes up shop (due to low attendance, convention organizers losing interest, etc.) and now suddenly there is no *DSC* planned for the following year and no seated *DSC* committee to deal with it. Upon learning this, the *SFC* Officers may put out requests to a different convention or conventions to host *DSC* during that year and choose from the best suitable candidate.

PASSINGS

CoastCon extended family, Gulf South convention volunteer/convention organizer, WWL & WYES television personality/film critic, long-time Fan, and previous CoastCon Fan Guest of Honor **Alfred Richard**, died on December 23, 2024 at Ochsner Hospital in Jefferson, Louisiana at 62 years of age.

CoastCon extended family, gamer, collector, volunteer, and Gulf coast local Fan **Jim Pierce** died in December 2024.

CoastCon extended family, CoastCon staff/volunteer, longtime Fan **George “Bubba” Spicuzza** (September 17, 1954, December 7, 2024) passed away after a short illness in Tyler Texas at 70 years of age. Frank Schiavo writes, “*From the early 1980’s forward, George was a familiar and welcome sight at conventions throughout the Southeast. He was a part of just so many groups and conventions in our area. Vulcon, CoastCon, Crescent City Con, The Patrol, SOB2, SwampCon, The Amalgamation, CoastCon Jr., PeliCon, NOSFFF, CONtraflow- you name the event or group in the area during the 1980’s and 1990’s- George was*

a part of it, worked for it, attended it, promoted it and/or supported it in some form or another. He was a very in demand volunteer and program participant who was great at public speaking, very charismatic, and infinitely knowledgeable on a vast array of topics- from New Orleans history (and history in general) to music, local food, Star Trek, SF and Fantasy Literature, and film.”

CoastCon extended family, award-winning costume/cosplay artisan, Fan group organizer/leader, convention volunteer, and regional super-fan **Sandy Bergeron Casella** (April 12, 1980, February 22, 2025), of Houma, LA, passed Saturday, February 22, 2025. Sandy was a pillar of the Cosplay Community, from *Connan, The Spartans of the 300*, an Amazonian warrior queen from Themyscira, a member of the *501st & Rebel Legions*, Pris from *Blade Runner*, *Princess Cecilia* at Renfairs and many others. She helped rebuild the metal bikini Leia community and made it a more welcoming place. She is a huge part of the Dragon Con family.

Linda Riley Zielke, of Chattanooga, TN, passed away at the age of 77, February 25th, 2025. She was a co-con-chair of the **DeepSouthCon 50** convention in Huntsville, AL in 2012 where she won the **Rebel Award**. She was a well known and well loved frequent attendee and volunteer at many southern conventions spanning several decades, especially Chattanooga’s **Chattacon** and **LibertyCon**. She help host innumerable room parties at many conventions over her many decades active in fandom. *{I also considered her a dear friend and will miss her.
